Mr. Dalal, has been through since 2002, concentrating on developing Senior Citizen communes across the country.

His company's domain expertise is in Creating Senior Communes from concept to commissioning to operations. They are the only consultants in India offering these holistic services for the Senior Living industry.

He is also the founder and chairman of ASLI (Association of Senior Living India) the first national professional trade association formed to represent senior living providers in India and to protect the interest of seniors. The acronym ASLI coined by him, meaning REAL, echoes the need for real and committed players in this nascent industry. Most of the Pan India players of this industry are members of this association. He is at the moment involved in formulating the first bye-laws, regulations and best practices for this industry.

Mr. Dalal has written countless articles since 2002 on Senior Living and has been extensively quoted and profiled in National and International magazines, media and trade journals.

He is invited extensively across the globe and in India to address seminars and conferences on the subject of Senior Living in India.

In 2011, he was the keynote speaker on India at the International retirement summit in Hongkong.

In 2011, he was also the Moderator in a panel discussion, during an international conference on retirement living in Delhi.

In 2012, he was invited to Dallas, USA by ALFA, (Assisted Living Federation of America) during their annual conference, comprising of 2500 delegates, to speak on the Indian status of this industry.

In 2013, he was invited to Singapore to speak on the same subject, for an International summit on ageing in S.E. Asia.

In 2014, he was the Chairman for the first 2day International conference of Senior Living held in Mumbai, India, wherein delegates from 6 countries participated, including USA, UK and Japan.

In January 2015, he was the keynote speaker for the Australian trade summit on Assisted Living in Pune.

In August 2015, he was invited, on scholarship, by Commonwealth Association for the Ageing, an organisation of Commonwealth countries to the IAHSA/ ACSA summit on Ageing, in Perth, Australia. He then had the opportunity to visit 5 cities to study various models of senior living in Australia.

In December 2015, he was the Chairman for the annual 2 day International conference of Senior Living held in Bangalore, India, wherein delegates from 4 countries participated.

THE NEST, of Bhopal, the latest project of OASIS Senior Living, has been shortlisted in the finals for the Facility of the year, Independent Living category. There are 5 finalists; the others are from Hong Kong, New Zealand, Philippines and Malaysia.

There were 150 entries from 15 countries of Asia- Pacific region.

This is for the first time that an Indian Project in this sector has made it to the finals, in an International forum vying for an Award, which is known as the Oscars of the senior living industry.

Mr. Dalal, is an Architect, who after 32 years of practice, across 26 cities, with a staff of 80, voluntarily closed operations, so as to devote his full time to the cause of Senior Living in India. www.mhdalal.com

He was recently invited by partners of T.I.S.S.(Tata Institute of Social Sciences) as a guest speaker for their aged Care certificate training programme to advise participants who are joining the work force for Aged care and Assisted Living, on their career scope within and outside the country.

After working for 14 years in this sector, Mr. Dalal is convinced that for this sector to grow in the right direction, training for aged care and a career path needs to be shown to our youngsters so that they take up this cause with a mission.
